

Waxahachie ISD Education Foundation Dual Credit Scholarship 2024

This scholarship was established in 2008 to aid Waxahachie High School students wishing to begin their college degrees at Navarro College. To apply, students must meet ALL OF the following criteria:

- Waxahachie High School student
- Student must have successfully completed the previous grade level
- Student must have met the academic qualifications to enroll in Dual Credit
- Student must qualify for support of financial need (**i.e. by providing current parent tax information, free or reduced lunch program, or other supporting information**). **If this information is not included with application, the application will not be considered.**
- Scholarships will be awarded to those demonstrating the most financial need first.
- Students receiving a Navarro College Brilliance scholarship are not eligible for an Education Foundation Scholarship.
- Dual Credit Scholarships will be awarded once a year, for both fall and spring semesters. If you wish to enroll in dual credit classes both semesters, please ensure you list all classes you would like to take on this application.
- If chosen for a Dual Credit Scholarship, you will be required to write thank you notes to specified Education Foundation donors.
- **ALL requested information MUST be included on submitted applications. The application will NOT be considered if all information is not included.**
